Care Coordination for heart patients receives a boost

A new Cardiac payment model from The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services is scheduled to go into effect from July 1, 2017 and will be mandatory for hospitals in 98 metropolitan statistical areas that would see about 1,220 hospitals participate. Non MSA counties were not eligible for selection.

Three new payment models support clinicians in providing care to patients who receive treatment for heart attacks, heart surgery to bypass blocked coronary arteries, or cardiac rehabilitation following a heart attack or heart surgery.

This holds hospitals financially accountable for episodes of care that last 90 days after inpatient discharge including all related care covered by Medicare Parts A and B. It includes payments for acute myocardial infarction, percutaneous coronary intervention and coronary artery bypass grafting procedures.
